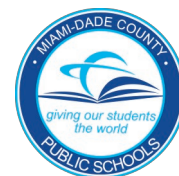
Application Process

- Two page application
- Provide transcripts evidencing 3.0 or higher of undergraduate GPA
- Evidence of teaching Mathematics or Science with a letter from your School Principal

Mathematics and Science Teachers

Florida International University in collaboration with Miami-Dade County Public Schools is offering a Graduate Certificate Program in Mathematics or Science teaching in Grades 6-8. Through this program, M-DCPS teachers will have the opportunity to enhance their skills and knowledge with a focus on content aligned with the Common Core State Standards and specific classroom practices. The certificate credits can be applied toward a graduate degree (MS or EdS) in Curriculum and Instruction at FIU through the Department of Teaching and Learning. Specific classroom practices including utilization of technology will broaden a teacher's area of expertise resulting in better test scores from their students.
