Free breakfast and lunch for all participants. Also, we're offering a \$300 stipend given to the first 20 teachers who apply and complete each workshop (40 teachers total).



*Computer Science Principles can be taught as an AP course or a non-AP course. The AP version has achieved a 75% passing rate nationwide in the the 2016-2017 school year. It has attracted 50% female and underrepresented minority students.
